## BASINGSTOKE BLUEFINS SWIMMING CLUB LEVEL 3 OPEN MEET, APRIL 2016 CONDITIONS

- 1. This event shall be conducted in accordance with ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules.
- 2. Any swimmer who is eligible as defined in ASA Law may enter this competition, providing that they have not, on the date of entry, achieved a time faster than the published upper limit times.
- 3. Swimmers who, on the date of entry, have already achieved a time faster than the published upper limit times may be accepted, if there is time available. Any swimmer who swims faster than the published upper limit time by more than the following will not be eligible for a medal, but will be awarded a speeding ticket:

50m swims: 0.5 secs 100m swims: 1 sec 200m swims: 2 secs

4. All ages as at midnight on 31st December 2016

Age groups:

- 10 Years
- 11 Years
- 12 Years
- 13 Years
- 14 Years
- 15 Years
- 16 Years and Open
- 5. In the interest of safety and to ensure the smooth running of the competition the number of overall entrants and or entries to any individual event is limited. If the whole competition or any individual event is oversubscribed, entries will be rejected on the following basis:
  - 1. Swimmers with entry times faster than the upper limit times
  - 2. Swimmers with no entry time.
  - 3. Swimmers with the slowest entry times.
- **6.** If the number of individual entrants exceeds the safe capacity of the pool hall, swimmers with the fewest swims will be rejected.
- 7. The entry fee shall be £5 per individual event. Entries must be club only; individual entries will not be accepted.
- **8.** Entries must be submitted via the electronic entry system on the web site by the published closing date. Late entries will NOT be accepted.
- **9.** Clubs will be invoiced for entry fees for accepted entries. Payment must be received in the Basingstoke Bluefins Meet account within 7 days of the invoice being issued. If payments are not received by this time, swimmers will forfeit the right to enter the meet.
- **10.** Confirmation of entry will be published on the web site at least 5 days before the date of competition. Clubs are responsible for checking their entry confirmation. Any errors found must be notified at least 4 days before the first day of the competition. Subsequent to this date, only errors introduced by Basingstoke Bluefins will be corrected.
- **11.** A withdrawal system will be in operation. Club representatives are expected to submit withdrawal forms for swimmers who are not intending to swim, no later than 30 minutes before the advertised starting time of the first event in the session. Competitors who fail to withdraw and do not present themselves at the start may be suspended from all further events at the competition.
- **12.** There will be no finals; all events shall be decided on a heat times and places (heat declared winner).
- **13.** All events shall be seeded slowest to fastest. The final heat in each event shall be spearheaded.
- **14.** Medals will be awarded to the first, second and third placed swimmers in each event. Medals will be available for collection as soon as results are published. There will be no presentations. All medals

must be collected at the end of the meet by the swimmer of their club representative. Unclaimed medals will be forfeit.

- **15.** By submitting an entry, entrants are implicitly accepting that entries will be processed using a computer system. Entrants may request that details are not displayed on the web site, but need to be aware that entry confirmation and results are not made available in any other form.
- **16.** Any matters concerning the Meet not covered in the conditions will be dealt with by the promoter within the rules of the sport.
